Original quarter grey cloth and illustrated boards; all edges trimmed; patterned endpapers; in original first-issue dust-jacket, with \$3.50 price and "40-80" and "1163" on front flap, as well as three-paragraph blurbs on front and rear flaps, and no mention of Caldecott Award, darkening to spine and extremities, small short closed tear at bottom edge of front panel.
